The Bahá'í Community in Belize, Central America, has an urgent need for mature Bahá'ís to come and live in its Bahá'í Centre in the capital city of Belmopan, as managers.

The qualities needed for this service are a spirit of hospitality and friendship, love for teaching the Cause of God and participation in and support of the Belmopan Bahá'í Community.

The main duties are to serve as a friendly host and support for national and local activities that take place there, including occasional institute training and national gatherings. Also needed is to keep the Centre and grounds clean and provide a presence for the Faith in the building. This is not a paid position. It is a service role, with a minimal rent expected (\$100 US, per month) as well as payment of personal utility usage. A minimum of a one year's commitment is needed.
