Three Nigeran exchange students (Roland Delu, Festus George and can't remember the third) were stranded in San Diego when the exchange parents from a Christian Church found out that African students were black. When Emma Jones found out about all this, she got hopping mad and drove to San Diego and brought them home so they could have a temporary place to stay until they got settled. Roland stayed the longest and gave Emma fits because he was a Prince and expected her (being a woman) to wait on him hand and foot, including running a shower for him. On one occasion he flooded the back part of the house by finishing his shower and leaving the water running – because she refused to turn it on for him. Festus George was a very happy, charming and charismatic person and made us laugh a lot.

Walter recorded the proceedings for this conference on 1/4 inch magnetic tape, but the results (after 1990 when he passed) were unintelligible. According to the Baha'i News U.S. Supplement No 76 June 1964, Hand of the Cause Zikru'llah Khadem was present with over 1500 in attendance including believers from all over the world, and afterwards "the inhabitants of the Navajo community of Pine Springs declared themselves almost without exception as followers of the new faith."
