A. PHILLIP RANDOLPH AND OWEN CHANDLER 'MESSENGER' EDITORS INDICTED

Chicago, Ill., March 5—(By ANP) Chandler Owen, co-editor of the Messenger Magazine and author of a series of articles, called "The Neglected Truth," now appearing in that magazine, and A. Phillip Randolph, also co-editor of the magazine and organizer of the Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters, have been indicted for conspiracy to libel, according to a true bill returned by the Cook County grand jury last Wednesday. This information was given by Joseph Bibb, editor of the Chicago Whip, against whom Mr. Owen's articles have been directed. Over the telephone, Mr. Bibb admitted that the Bibb-MacNeal Publishing Company had preferred charges against Randolph and Owen and that a capias had been issued for their arrest Tuesday morning. No verification of the report could be obtained from the office where Owen works. One of the employees denied that the report was true.
