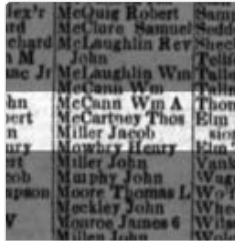

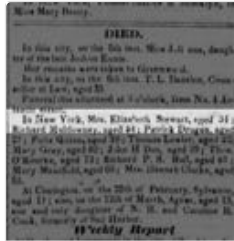

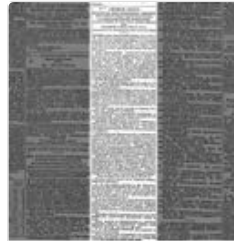


Possible death notice for Elizabeth Vance Stewart - 7 Apr 1851
