

From the crystal springs of Thy love suffer me to quaff, O my Glory, and beneath the shadow of Thine everlasting providence let me abide, O my Light! Within the meadows of Thy nearness, before Thy presence, make me able to roam, O my Beloved, and at the right hand of the throne of Thy mercy, seat me, O my Desire! From the fragrant breezes of Thy joy let a breath pass over me, O my Goal, and into the heights of the paradise of Thy reality let me gain admission, O my Adored One! To the melodies of the dove of Thy oneness suffer me to hearken, O Resplendent One, and through the spirit of Thy power and Thy might quicken me, O my Provider! In the spirit of Thy love keep me steadfast, O my Succorer, and in the path of Thy good pleasure set firm my steps, O my Maker! Within the garden of Thine immortality, before Thy countenance, let me abide for ever, O Thou Who art merciful unto me, and upon the seat of Thy glory stablish me, O Thou Who art my Possessor! To the heaven of Thy loving-kindness lift me up, O my Quickener, and unto the Daystar of Thy guidance lead me, O Thou my Attractor! Before the revelations of Thine invisible spirit summon me to be present, O Thou Who art my Origin and my Highest Wish, and unto the essence of the fragrance of Thy beauty, which Thou wilt manifest, cause me to return, O Thou Who art my God!

His wide-ranging achievements, spread over many decades, are the fruits of a life lived with selfless devotion to the Faith. Not long after enrolling as a Bahá'í, he answered the call of the beloved Guardian for believers to go to Africa, and there he was named a Knight of Bahá'u'lláh for French Somaliland. He also travelled as a pioneer to several countries in Latin America. His efforts to encourage Bahá'í youth were a notable feature of his thirteen years as a Continental Counsellor in the Americas, years which culminated in his appointment to the International Teaching Centre. His wisdom, kindness, and good humour, combined with a practical approach and friendly demeanour, enabled him in so many settings to advance the Cause and to help others develop a capacity for service.

In the Holy Shrines we will supplicate for the progress of his illumined soul, now reunited in the realms above with his dear wife, Julia. To his three children, as well as other family members, we offer our condolences. We call for memorial gatherings to be held in his honour in all Houses of Worship and in Bahá'í communities throughout the world.

MESSAGE FROM THE NATIONAL SPIRITUAL ASSEMBLY OF THE BAHÁ'ÍS OF THE UNITED STATES

To the children of Mr. Fred Schechter

Dearest Bahá'í Friends,

We share your sorrow in the passing of dear Fred Schechter, your beloved father and our good friend, a man whose warmth and loving kindness, genuine humility, and ready—but always gentle—sense of humor made for a presence that lifted spirits and inspired them to greater heights of service. Even as we mourn his departure and the loss of his delightful company, we join you in celebrating his nearly nine decades of this life—a life truly well spent, for the greater part of it was devoted to energetic, wholehearted, and faithful service to God, to humanity, and to the Bahá'í Faith he embraced as a young man barely out of his teens.

Teacher, administrator, international pioneer, trusted member of some of the Faith's most senior institutions—the number and scope of Fred's significant and historic contributions to the worldwide advance of Bahá'u'lláh's unifying teachings are beyond our ability to adequately recount in the limited space afforded by a letter. Yet, moved by warmest admiration, we cannot fail to marvel at the intrepid spirit that motivated Fred—inspired by the beloved Guardian's Ten Year World Crusade and its call for believers to take the Faith to the many corners of the world that had yet to be touched by it—to arise and all alone set out for the African nation then called French Somaliland. Though just 26 and a recent college graduate, this act of unselfish obedience earned Fred membership in the company of those honored by Shoghi Effendi with the immortal designation "Knight of Bahá'u'lláh."

From that auspicious start, years of similarly brave pioneering efforts followed, taking Fred successively to a great number of the diverse nations of Latin America. It was during this period of tireless itinerant teaching that he met his beloved bride, Julia—your dear late mother—who became his steadfast and enthusiastic support in nearly a quarter century of appointed service as an Auxiliary Board member, Continental Counselor, and Counselor member of the International Teaching Center.

Without a doubt, Fred's stellar record of service to our sacred Cause has added imperishable luster to the annals of the American Bahá'í community, and our hearts swell with joy and pride to claim him among the heroes of Faith born on this soil.

We extend our heartfelt condolences on the loss you—his cherished daughter, Amy, and sons, Charles and Jim—have sustained, asking you to share them with your respective spouses, with Fred's adored grand-children, and with all other family members. Be assured your dear father will be fondly remembered in our prayers in the stillness of the great Auditorium of the Mother Temple of the West, where we will offer supplications for the eternal progress of his radiant soul—reunited now with his beloved Julia in the realms of pure spirit that await the faithful on the opposite shore of this life.
