This morning Toolba Khacum told me the following as he sat in the garden she said:

That Baba's'llah while in Sulamanyeh mountains - was visited one day by a young boy - for whom he wrote a copy of the alphabet (Mashk) for him to learn - When some people saw this, they wondered that a Persian could write so well - gradually others went to him for these copies -

At that time Bagdad was the place of exile for all the Shah's enemies - political etc, and there was quite a group of them - some thirty. These, heard of us this Persian and wanted to see him - gradually they became very friendly - It was really because of this friendship that ~~the people~~ what the Shah sent Baba's'llah and all away to Constantinople -

Pasha's 'black women' tell these stories to  
 her family -  
 At Ark only few people even call him,  
 one was a Christian, one a Greek, ~~other~~  
 an mufti - and an arab dealer,  
 This same mufti declared from the pulpit -  
 that arrived and warned all the prisoners  
 to have nothing to do with these prisoners,  
 He became quickly a great friend of Abu &  
Pasha, and it was he who helped Pasha to

 The dealer because very friendly - and it -  
 was then that the letter to the King came  
 out, he arrived then on his good man  
 his hat, and fringed them.
