

Fariduddin Radmehr was born in Tehran in 1338 (Persian calendar/1959 CE) into a Bahá'í family. He began his elementary education in Tehran and then received his mathematics diploma from Kharazmi High School. From adolescence, he was interested in religious and philosophical studies, especially Bahá'í research. In 1356 (1977 CE), he entered Aryamehr University in electrical engineering and simultaneously developed an interest in logic and philosophy studies at the same university. After the Islamic Revolution in Iran in 1357 (1978 CE) and subsequent developments, in 1359 (1980 CE) during the Cultural Revolution, he was expelled from university due to being Bahá'í. From then on, he continued his studies and research in philosophy, mysticism, sociology, and religious studies while simultaneously expanding his services in teaching and education. The results of his studies and research have been published professionally in the form of books and articles. He serves as a professor teaching the history of social thought in sociology and specialized courses in Sufism and mysticism, Rumi and the Masnavi, and mystical texts in Persian language and literature. His books have been published both in Iran and abroad (the abbreviation "n.a" refers to Bahá'í research in the form of limited publications in Iran).
