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Dear friends!

In the sacred silence of the Holy Tomb of Baha-O-llah, in the blessed Presence of Abdul Baha, on this beautiful Christmas day we remembered and prayed for you. Although you were very far in body, yet you were very near in spirit. The day was perfectly cloudless, the azure heaven was a deep blue vault and the weather was bracing and cool. A more perfect sunlit day, a more perfect moonlit and starlit night one's heart could not wish for. It was one of those fairy days one reads in fairy books. Our hearts leaped forth with the joy of living and with the privilege of possessing the knowledge of the matchless harmony of Truth. With fresh zeal and the fervency of spirit we prayed for the early establishment of the Kingdom of God upon earth, the bringing about of Millennium and the hoisting of the Banner of Justice and Mercy. For the winning of this heavenly Prize humanity must put forward an extraordinary effort, a self-denial which shall be high and a sincerity which shall be deep. At 8 P.M. he sent for the believers who had gathered in the lower room and he was just going to speak when the commissioner of Police entered and his presence naturally changed the current of the Beloved's talk. Later on Tahseem Bey, the commander and the military governor of Hauran with his attaché and other prominent citizens called and stayed till 11 o'clock. For an hour he spoke about criminology and that the prime object of the wardens of Prisons and Penitentiaries must be correction and education and not revenge and punishment. As long as humanity is in the cradle, my friend state these corrective measures are necessary to safeguard the society from anarchistic outbreaks and lawlessness. It is hoped however that moral education and enlightenment will do away with vices and crimes to the extent that man may consider the committing of a crime as the greatest punishment.
